

Pfizer COVID Vaccine Available to Children Ages 12-15

The Trousdale County Health Department is able to vaccinate children ages 12-15 years with the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved Pfizer vaccine. Trousdale County Schools is assisting the Trousdale County Health Department in getting information out to families regarding free COVID vaccinations for eligible children.

QUESTIONNAIRE

Complete the questionnaire with your child's information including name, address, gender, race, and date of birth. Please use the parent/guardian's telephone or cell phone number and email address in the designated areas. Once the questionnaire is complete and submitted, you'll be prompted to schedule an appointment at the Trousdale County Health Department.

VACCINATION SITES

In addition to the Trousdale County Health Department vaccination site, there are also other opportunities for children and adults to receive their vaccine for free this summer. To locate a vaccine provider in Trousdale and surrounding counties, visit www.vaccinefinder.org for more information.

It's important to note that vaccinated persons are not required to quarantine if they are fully vaccinated (two weeks following receipt of the second dose in a two-dose series) and have remained asymptomatic since exposure to COVID-19.

RISING 7TH GRADERS

Rising 7th graders are required to have a Tdap vaccine booster before the start of school in August 2021. The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) has lifted restrictions for receiving Tdap and COVID vaccine at the same time or at any time before or after a dose of the COVID vaccine. Please contact your local physician's office or the health department to schedule your child's Tdap vaccination.
