Remote Learning Plan in the Event of a Temporary Classroom or School Building Closure

Per guidance from the Tennessee Department of Education (TDOE), Trousdale County Schools may seek TDOE's approval for temporary closure of individual classrooms and/or school buildings if the public health situation deems it necessary for the health and safety of students and staff. In the event of a temporary school building closure, teaching and learning will continue and designated school(s) will immediately transition to remote learning procedures.

Remote Learning Procedures for All School(s) Affected by Temporary Closure:

- Schools will immediately transition from in-person to remote learning starting with the first day of classroom or building closure.
 - Students should bring their provided devices home every day to be prepared for a potential closure at any time.
- Schools will remain on their regular daily schedule (ex: A/B days and beginning class times/bell schedules).
 - Class schedules can be located on each teacher's website at www.tcschools.org > School > Quick Links > Teacher Websites > Teacher Name
- Students are required to join their Google Meeting at the beginning of every regularly scheduled class time (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies, CTE, and grades 9-12 Art and 9-12 Music).
 - Students must log in at the beginning of class in order to be counted present.
 - Every Google Meeting class session will include a bell ringer assignment. Students without internet access at home who cannot join the Google Meeting sessions must submit the bell ringer assignment within 5 days to be counted present.
 - After 5 school days have passed, students who have not logged in or submitted the bell ringer shall be counted as absent for that day.
- Student lessons/assignments are located in the Assignment Sheet located on each teacher's website and within each teacher's Google Classroom.
 - Students must submit assignments for grading and promotion.
 - Students and parents can expect that students will have at least two graded assignments per class during a temporary closure.
 - Student grades can be found on the PowerSchool Parent Portal.
- Student lunches will be provided at each individual school. Pick-up times will be from 11:30 A.M. to 12:00 P.M.

Additionally, the following procedures apply to specific schools:

Elementary School:

- Optional Related Arts Activities (PE, Music, Art, Wellness, Library) are located on the respective teacher's website.
- For Google Meet class times, see your teacher's websites and/or Google Classroom.

Middle School:

- For academic content class times (math, English language arts, science, social studies), please see your teachers' websites.
- Optional Related Arts Activities (PE, Music, Art, Keyboarding, Career Exploration) are located on respective teachers' websites.

High School:

- **LUNCH Times** will follow current Lunch Schedules (example Woodard 3A 1st lunch 11:10 – 11:40)—if you are unsure about your specific lunch time, contact your 3rd block teacher
- **SENIORS**—check your Google Classrooms for Seniors 2021-22 Guidance & (if applicable) Senior Seminar—Mrs. Cunningham & Senior Seminar teachers will make important announcements for Scholarships and Graduation

Guidance for students without home internet access:

- Students without Internet access at home can access their class content and assignments using their provided devices and community WiFi access points.
 - For attendance, students will submit daily bell ringer assignments within five days to be counted as present for that day.
- Access points are available at the following locations:
 - All Trousdale County Schools provide free WiFi access at designated parking lot locations.
 - Tri County Electric provides free WiFi at the Football Stadium, Baseball/Softball Stadium, Trey Park/Swimming Pool, and the Court House.
 - Free WiFi is also available at the Vaught Library, Sonic, and McDonalds.
