Distance Learning Guidance in the Event of a School Closure

In the event of a school closure, the affected school(s) will transition to the following procedures:

All Schools:

- The present hybrid school schedule will transition to a 5-day per week distance learning delivery through Google Classroom (grades 4-12) and teacher websites (grades Pre-Kindergarten through 3rd grade). Student work submissions are required for grading and promotion.
- Student's instructional day shall be from 7:45 A.M. – 2:45 P.M. each day. No instruction will be provided after 3:00 P.M. Teacher office hours to support students remain as scheduled.
- All students (in grades 4-12) shall login to their Google Classroom between 7:45 and 8:00 A.M. each morning to receive their lessons/assignments and to be accounted present for the day.
- Students shall verify daily attendance in the same manner as a Learn from Home Day. Attendance criteria is available on page 16 of the Trousdale County Education Plan 2020-21 for Reopening Schools located on the 2020-21 Distance Learning tab found by accessing the district website at www.tcschools.org
- K-5 and Special Services Wednesday will be postponed. Wednesdays shall become a regular instructional school day for all students.
- All school extracurricular activities and sports shall be canceled during the school(s) closure.
- Student meals will be provided at individual school sites in the event of a single school closure. All meals will be provided at the high school in the event of a district-wide closure. Pick-up times will be from 11:00 A.M. to 12:30 P.M.
